

The Way Forward





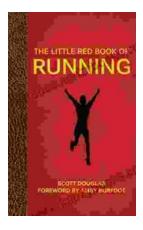
